Established in 2006 through foreign and Ukrainian investments, Volyn-Kalvis is dedicated to producing high-quality, cost-effective heating equipment, enjoying a strong reputation as a dependable partner across Ukraine.

As a manufacturer, <u>Volyn-Kalvis</u> depends heavily on electricity, but rising energy costs due to the Russia-Ukraine conflict imperilled their mission to offer affordable pricing. In order to safeguard their reputation and ensure that the quality of their products remained uncompromised, it was imperative for Volyn-Kalvis to reduce operating expenses.

Recognising the importance of responsible energy management, Volyn-Kalvis turned to renewable energy sources as a viable solution.



Through the financial support provided by the "Bring Energy to Your Business" initiative, facilitated by Bank Lviv, the company made a strategic investment in a solar PV. In May 2023, they successfully began generating their own electricity.

Installing the solar PV plant has yielded substantial benefits. Volyn-Kalvis has managed to reduce its energy costs by almost 50% from May to August, and by 30% in September. These energy savings have not only bolstered the company's financial health but have also enabled the installation of equipment capable of operating during nighttime hours, resulting in an augmented production capacity without incurring additional expenses.
